Note:** This collection contains an indenture conveyed from Philip J. Guilmartin, New York, New York, to Laurence J. Guilmartin, Chatham County, Georgia, on August 20, 1883. The indenture conveyed 1/4 interest in John Guilmartin's estate including tracts in Polk, Cobb, Whitfield, Paulding, Walker, Dawson, Forsyth, Bartow, Floyd, and Cherokee counties in Georgia for \$75.00.**Preferred Citation:** [item identification], Philip J. Craw correspondence, abstracts, and indentures, MS 1023.**Biog./Historical Note:** Laurence J. Guilmartin, 1826-1902, was a Savannah, Georgia merchant between 1850 and 1886. Guilmartin owned L. J. Guilmartin & Company, selling produce and hides. He was a member of the Hibernian Society and sat on the Board of Directors for the Savannah Cotton Exchange from 1872-1873. Guilmartin married Frances J. Lloyd of St. Augustine, Florida in 1854. In 1858, Guilmartin became the guardian of his nephew, Philip J. Guilmartin, a resident of New York, New York. In 1861, Laurence Guilmartin joined the Confederate Army. After the Civil War he returned to his business in Savannah.
