And by these presents do make this our act and deed irrevocable under any pretence whatever, and have put the said Bernardus James and William Harsen in full possession and Seizin by delivering them a piece of the said Tract on the premises. In witness whereof we the said chiefs for ourselves and in behalf of our whole Nation of Chippaways, have unto these presents set the marks of our different tribes at Detroit the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty three 1783.

 town of Detroit aforesaid contain-
 ing Thirty three feet four inches
 front and rear, and Twenty
 two feet six inches in depth
 bounded in the front by St. Ann's
 Street in the rear by Thomas
 McCrae's Lot on the West-South
 West by Catharine Grills Lot and
 on the East North-East by the
 said William Grosbeck's Lot with
 all and singular the appurtenances
 unto the said Messuage or
 tenement and Lot of Ground
 belonging or in anywise apper-
 taining and also all the Estate
 Right Title Interest, Claim or
 Demand of me the said William
 Grosbeck of, in and to the said
 Messuage tenement and Lot of
 Ground and of in and to every
 part and parcel thereof.
 To have and to hold the

said Message, Tenement and Lot of Ground, with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging, unto the said John Kingie his heirs and assigns for the only proper use and behoof of the said John Kingie his heirs and assigns for ever. And I the said William Grosbeck for myself my heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever. The said Message Tenement and Lot of Ground and every part and parcel thereof I shall and will warrant and for ever defend by virtue of these presents.
