Services for Mrs. Guy A. (Mary W.) Pillsbury, 68, 1114 Gilbert Avenue, an artist who completed 156 paintings while living in the Philippines 10 years, will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday in G.H. Herrmann Madison Avenue Funeral Home, with burial in Forest Lawn Cemetery.

She died Wednesday in St. Francis Hospital.

A native of Grafton, W.Va., and an Indianapolis resident 15 years, Mrs. Pillsbury was one of the founders of the Indianapolis Art League. She and her husband moved later to the Philippines, where he was employed by the National Cash Register Company. Her paintings were predominantly religious. She also was an accomplished violinist and poet.

Besides her husband, Mrs. Pillsbury is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Margo Brackett, and her mother, Mrs. Margaret Noble, both of Indianapolis.
