At the Sioux Mission of St. Francis, Rosebud, S.D., on Sunday, May 10, 1970, a statue of the Venerable Kateri Tekakwitha was solemnly dedicated by Bishop Harold J. Dimmerling of Rapid City. It was cast from the same mold that Sculptor Emile Brunet had prepared for the original statue, erected in 1954, at the Mission of St. Francis Xavier where the Lily of the Mohawks died on April 17, 1680.
