

KATERI STATUE IN THE CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY OF THE VIRGIN MARY - LA PRAIRIE (DE-LA-MAGDELEINE)



Kateri left Fonda during the autumn, of 1677 heading for the Jesuit Mission of St Francis Xavier in La-Prairie-de-la-Magdeleine. With her companions, they crossed several rivers around Lake Champlain. Their final route in Canada was from the Richelieu river (north), then to rivière Saint-Jacques (west). They then moved south on the Saint Lawrence River several times before settling in today's Ville Saint-Catherine, near the Church of Sainte-Catherine-d'Alexandrie - not too far from today's Seaway's multiple locks.
