

## KATERI'S RELICS IN THE HURON MISSION OF OUR LADY OF LORETTO (QUEBEC)



The Huron Chapel of Loretto (Wendake, Qc), dedicated to Our Lady of Loretto - Built under the direction of Father Pierre-Daniel Richer S.J. in 1730. Partially destroyed by fire in 1862. Recognized as a historical monument in 1957. This Church is closely linked to the Huron-Wendat Nation. It was built on the model of the Santa Casa of Loretto in Italy. After the fire, it was renovated a few years later, and in the early twentieth century, a side chapel and a sacristy were added. Inside the Church, today, one can find a small shrine dedicated to Saint Kateri Tekakwitha.
