Pawhuska National Guard Armory

The Army National Guard Armory in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, was constructed in 1937-38 at 836 East 8th Street. The historical use of the building was to house a body of the Oklahoma National Guard. The surrounding area was developed into residential properties during and after the construction of the armory. The DEQ completed remediation activities on December 5, 2011. The Armory is currently housing the Bronze Horse Foundry, and vehicle storage for the city of Pawhuska.
